Inspection services for the entrance/arrival of aircraft at Snohomish County Airport - Paine Field are available Monday-Friday, 0800-1600 in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures.

Commercial aircraft operators departing the U.S. must obtain an outbound clearance by contacting CBP directly.

Permission to Land Procedures

Snohomish County Airport - Paine Field (KPAE) is designated as a "landing rights airport" [19 CFR 122.1(f);19 CFR 122.14].

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from the foreign airport and at least one business day in advance of the anticipated arrival time at KPAE. Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those parameters, you must contact CBP to resecure permission to land.



Inspection Process

- Aircraft should park at the FBO.
- There is no CBP office at this location.
- A CBP Officer will meet the aircraft on the ramp to begin the inspection.
- All crew and passengers will be processed planeside.
- Be prepared to present passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration and user fee decal (if appropriate).
- There is no USDA compliance agreement in place at this airport for the collection of regulated waste/garbage.



Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- CBP Officers travel from Everett, WA to service aircraft arrivals at this airport; accurate ETAs and timely updates to ETAs are critical.
- KPAE has limited immigration processing capabilities. If arriving with other than U.S. or Canadian citizens on board, please contact CBP to discuss feasibility.
- Advise CBP if transporting live animals, weapons, hunting trophies, or commercial imports.
